

The Fostering Linkages in Academic Innovation and Research (FLAIR) Programme of the Department of Higher Education is happy to announce your selection for the FLAIR National Internships 2016-17 (Selection list published in www.flairkerala.org is attached for reference). The internship offers a chance to move with experienced professors of national institutions of repute and observe the teaching-learning practice.

The primary objective of the internship is to motivate faculty members to make meaningful contributions to the Higher Education system in the State to bring in a new quality culture in our Colleges and Universities. The FLAIR Interns are supposed to document a good practice in teaching-learning in the host institution for implementation in the State. Also, the interns have to share his/her experiences with the other faculty members of the parent institution on completion of the internship.

The internship has to be carried out during the period May 2017- June 2017 in identified national institutions so as to complete the programme during the extended Plan period 2016-17. The internship grant includes honorarium for the mentor of the host institution (Rs30,000/-), Institutional fee (Rs 20,000/-), living and contingent expenses for the intern for the period of internship.

The internship grant will be transferred in two installments to the intern's bank account after getting a receipt. The bank account details may be intimated at the earliest.

Interns are also expected to submit Internship report highlighting the best practices observed along with vouchers and expenditure statement within one week of completion of the internship.
