The Academic Council meeting resolved to approve and recommend to the Governing Council the decision to follow the syllabi of MG University for second language French for under graduate programmes.

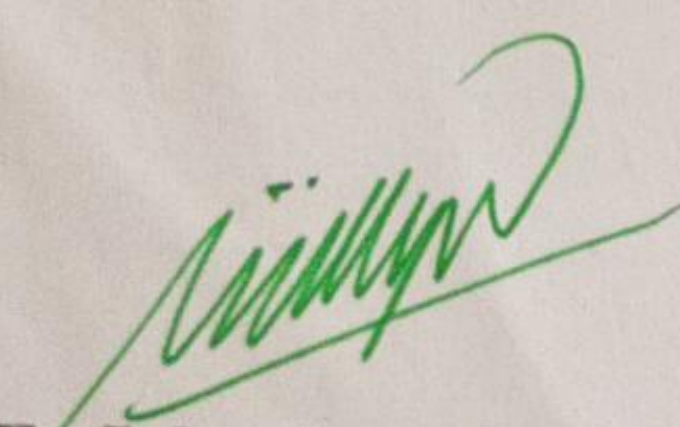
