About the Workshop

Complex analysis is the area of Mathematics dealing with complex numbers and the functions of complex numbers. It deals with analytic concepts such as limits, derivatives, integrals and infinite series. The first indications that complex numbers might prove useful emerged in the 16th century from the solution of certain algebraic equations by the Italian mathematicians Girolamo Cardano and Raphael Bombelli. By the 18th century, after a lengthy and controversial history, they became fully established as sensible mathematical concepts. Many of the more advanced aspects of complex analysis are quite abstract. This Workshop will serve as a bridge course for MSc students. It is conducted as part of IMRT-Workshops: "Mathematics Enrichment Programme for Graduate Students". The Workshop contains both lectures and problem solving sessions.
