COURSE CODE	TITLE OF THE COURSE	DESCRIPTION	
<b>1</b>	BECEX01	Human Rights Education	The Certificate Course in Human Rights Education is aimed at making the learners acquire conceptual clarity and develop respect for human rights norms and values and make the learners sensitive to the weaker and the vulnerable sections of the society. It includes awareness of civil society organizations and rights movements for promoting human rights. The course is meant for Undergraduate students of all disciplines.
<b>2</b>	BDPS402	Indian Government and Political Process	The course on Indian Government and Political Process aims to give a comprehensive outlook on the major emerging aspects of the discipline of political science. The study of political systems, political structures and functions, human rights, UNO and the new world order etc. will provide an updated knowledge to the students. The area of public administration is included to give an additional awareness about the actual governance of the political system.
<b>3</b>	BDPS301	Principles of Political Science	The course on Principles of Political Science aims to give a wider knowledge about the subject in an interdisciplinary perspective. Political theories, major approaches, key issues, different ideologies and new theoretical concepts, Constitution and Constitutionalism etc. are included to make the study more meaningful and relevant.

<b>4</b>	BDHS101	Making of Indian Nation	This Course enables students to understand the various aspects of freedom struggle in the context of Colonial Past.
<b>5</b>	BBEC508	Environmental Economics and Human Rights	The main objective of this course is to understand the main concepts, theories and issues on Environmental economics and human rights.
<b>6</b>	BBEN508	Environment, Human Rights, and Literature	The objective of this course is to instill in students, a sense of bond with nature and making them aware of their rights through literature and to develop a sense of social commitment through literature.
<b>7</b>	BBEN614	Indian English Literature	The Objective of the Course is to introduce students to the thematic concerns, genres and trends of Indian writing in English and expose students to the pluralistic aspects of Indian culture and identity and to help students engage with the questions of language, nation, and aesthetics.
<b>8</b>	BBEJ202	Constitution and Media Laws	This Course may introduce students to legal and ethical aspects of the Press, its values and responsibility
<b>9</b>	BBEV508	Reflections on Environment and Human Rights	The course “Reflections on Environment and Human Rights” focuses on exploring the environmental issues and human rights, and how they impact individuals and communities. It aims to develop a critical understanding of environmental



			and human rights issues, and to encourage students to reflect on their responsibilities and actions.
<b>10</b>	BBML505	Paristithivinjaneeeyavum Manushyavakashapadavum	In an era of Human Rights violation and environmental pollution this course intends to impart a clear understandings on Environment and Human Rights
<b>11</b>	BBBT609	Industrial and Environmental Biotechnology	The objective of the course motivate students to develop innovative bio-remedial measures to reduce pollution and to exploit the industrial applications of various microbes to produce commercially important novel products.
<b>12</b>	BBBO506	Ecology, Environmental Science and Human rights	This Course aims at developing an awareness about Human Rights and Ecology among Students.
<b>13</b>	BBBO2B03	Plant Diversity, Conservation and Applied Botany	The Course deals with Conservation of Plant Diversity and using Botany in a pragmatic way. This course also deals with various laws related to environmental conservation.
<b>14</b>	BBCH506	Environmental Science and Human Rights	The outcome of this course includes acquainting students with basic human rights of an individual, Nature conservation, energy conservation and effects of toxic heavy metals to the environment



<b>15</b>	BBMB611	Microbial Waste Management	This course deals with the study of the composition, physiology and significance of microbial communities in the environment and the microbial degradation of organic matter. The Course is helpful in understanding various aspects of environmental microbiology and comprehend about water pollution, water-borne diseases and their transmission.
<b>16</b>	BBMM508	Environmental Issues, Human Rights and Differential Equations	This course will provide a clear idea about the national and international perspectives of human rights and enrich the students about the environmental issues that challenges the human existence. The Course also Provide an idea about the role of differential equations in environmental issues.
<b>17</b>	BBZO405	Research Methodology and Biostatistics	This course for Zoology includes animal laws in India, Animal Welfare board of India and bioethics
<b>18</b>	BBZO508	Environmental Biology and Human Rights	This course discusses about various types of Anthropogenic pressures on ecosystem, related degradation and management measures and is also aimed to create awareness about human rights and prevent its violation
<b>19</b>	BBZO6E01	Wildlife Biology, Conservation and Management	Wildlife Biology, Conservation, and Management is a course that focuses on the study of wild animals and their habitats, as well as the methods used to protect and manage these populations and ecosystems. This course covers topics such as wildlife ecology, population dynamics, habitat management, and conservation strategies, and prepares students

			for careers in wildlife biology and conservation.
<b>20</b>	BOZO501	Health and wellness	Health and Wellness is a course that explores the importance of maintaining physical and mental health. It covers topics such as healthy lifestyle choices, stress management, nutrition, and physical fitness.
<b>21</b>	BBCS515	Environmental studies	Environmental Studies aims to educate students on environmental issues, equip them with knowledge and skills to identify and evaluate problems, and foster their ability to participate in activities aimed at protecting the environment and promoting the well-being of all living things. This course is designed to raise awareness and inculcate responsible environmental management practices.
<b>22</b>	BBCS618	Cyber security and Cyber laws	The course "Cyber Security and Cyber Laws" provides an in-depth understanding of the principles and protocols of internetworks, information security, cryptography and digital signatures, malicious software and firewalls, and cyber crime. It aims to equip students with the knowledge and skills necessary to protect against cyber threats and understand the legal frameworks surrounding cyber security.
<b>23</b>	BBPH6E02	Renewable Energy technology	Renewable Energy Technology course focuses on creating awareness about energy crisis and alternative solutions, and understanding the challenges and



			environmental impacts of different energy sources.
<b>24</b>	BBPH507	Environmental science and Human rights	The course "Environmental Science and Human Rights" focuses on building the knowledge and skills to address environmental issues and understand the impact of decisions on the environment. It also emphasizes the importance of environmental awareness and promoting the resolution of human rights issues.
<b>25</b>	BBCM419	Goods and services tax	The Goods and Service Tax (GST) course provides an in-depth understanding of the concept and implementation of the GST system in India. It covers the concepts of indirect tax, GST laws, and procedures, as well as its impact on various sectors.

<b>27</b>	BBCM524	Income Tax Law and Practising	Income Tax Law and Practice is a course that focuses on the study of the laws and regulations governing the taxation of individuals and organizations in India. <b>29</b>	BMBAHR03	Labour Legislations	Labour Legislation and Practices is a course that focuses on the legal framework surrounding employment and labour relations in India. The course aims to provide students with an understanding of the laws and regulations governing working conditions, industrial relations, and labour welfare and social security.

The course aims to equip students with a good understanding of the Indian Constitution, legal procedures, and the skills to protect the rights of marginalized groups in society.
