1	BMSW102:	Understanding and Addressing Social Problems in Indian Context	The course "Understanding and Addressing Social Problems in Indian Context" provides an in-depth examination of prevalent social issues affecting marginalized groups such as women, children, elderly, and ethnic minorities. It highlights the causes and effects of early marriage, dowry, gender discrimination, domestic violence, and more.
