It also focused on the six parameters of OBE as projected in Bloom’s Taxonomy
2020-21	A Workshop on OBE was organized by IQAC on August 19, 2020, with about 25 participants. The workshop created great awareness among the faculties on Outcome-based education and the need for restructuring the curriculum
2020-21	Behavioural economics is a blend of traditional neoclassical microeconomics and empirically motivated assumptions whose goal is a better understanding of economic behaviour. A Five-day Online Faculty Development Program in Behavioural Economics was organized from August 22-26, 2020, with about 20 participants
