Report of the College, 2017-18

As the Principal of the college, I am honored and proud to present before you a consolidated report of the college for the academic year 2017-18.

The college reopened on 1st June 2017 after the summer vacation. We have at present 15 undergraduate programmes, 19 post graduate programmes, 2 B Voc programmes, 3 M.Phil programmes and 8 Ph.D programmes. The college has 109 permanent teachers 59 guest teachers and 37 ministerial staff and 20 other supporting staff. The student strength for the academic year is as follows.

St. Berchmans Centre for Extension Activities
