


Profile of the respondents -

Programme wise proportion of the respondents




Out of the total sample, 55% were graduates and reaming 45% were postgraduates.


Opinion on teaching learning process




Opinion on design and review of course/syllabus



Opinion on examination




Opinion on administration and functioning of office (do corrections from here 27 jan)






Opinion on canteen



Opinion on facilities available in the laboratories




Opinion on facilities available inside the classrooms (ICT and other facilities)




OPINION ON CO CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Opinion on arts and sports




Opinion on extension activities /NSS/NCC/ clubs etc.

Findings

- Programmes that can enhance the skills of students must be organised on a regular basis.
