
Methodology








The sequence of the courses (order of subjects in semesters) that I have studied in the programme is excellent.


The Electives/ Specializations offered were appropriate






The text books and reference books provided and suggested were adequate for the study


The content of the syllabus in terms of the load on the student is appropriate




On an average most of the teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.




The institution offered multiple opportunities to learn and grow.




The overall quality of teaching-learning process in the institution is very good.




The entire learning process helped me to attain cognitive, social and emotional growth.




The entire learning process supported me to be a more responsible citizen




The college took active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.




The programme (UG/PG) increased my confidence and I felt that I have become more employable.

Findings

- Latest changes in the discipline must be included in the curriculum.
- More ICT, Virtual tours, subject updating seminars, case studies etc must be included in the curriculum.
- Pre course materials and other reference materials must be circulated through Linways the LMS of the college.
- Make sure that the students get sufficient time to learn each course satisfactorily.
- Use more modern evaluation tools that can provide opportunities to the learners to demonstrate the knowledge and skills acquired.
- There should be proper synchronization of curricular and co-curricular activities.
- Check whether there is any need to rearrange the sequencing of courses.
- Check the relevance and appropriateness of optional courses
- Take necessary efforts by departments to arrange internships, student exchange, field visit opportunities, for students.
- Conduct periodical evaluation of laboratories, internet café, and library and computer labs.
- Make sure that all the above mentioned have adequate facilities expected by the students.

Action taken

- Heads of the Departments were directed to update the syllabus add on courses offered by their departments
- Teachers were asked to use the LMS of the college effectively to provide reference materials, conduct online examinations etc.
- Meeting of the finance committee, library committee were held and was decided to examine the sufficiency of facilities available in library, inter net café, laboratories etc.
- It was decided to invite alumni of the college who excel in various fields, to interact with the students.
- Decision was taken to offer more short term training programmes, which are relevant.
- Decision was taken to offer more facilities that ensure the academic and nonacademic growth of the students.
